Career Trek provides participants the opportunity to explore a variety of careers using an interactive, experiential approach, in a safe, supportive environment. Each lesson provides a hands-on experience, includes personal reflection, and showcases different occupations and the education paths that lead to them. Participants learn about themselves and their goals, while exploring their likes, dislikes, and unique potential.
